In late August 2022, when Roland Boehrer was the Acting Sheriff, the office of District Attorney Tasha Mosley began an in-depth investigation into criminal cases occurring at the Clayton County Jail. This office had received several warrants from the Clayton County Sheriff's Office regarding criminal conduct in the jail. We also fielded multiple telephone calls from family members and defense attorneys concerning those issues.

During our review of the warrants and reports, it became clear that these incidents were not isolated. The criminal activity continued to occur in 2023 while the active investigation was underway. At that point, Chief Investigator Brian Busch assigned all jail related cases to Investigator Terry Tuck. Assistant District Attorney Evan Hansinger was assigned to coordinate the investigation. Their exhaustive investigation revealed an ongoing criminal enterprise that was taking place inside the Clayton County Jail. Over the course of our investigation a number of suspects not previously named were identified. The hard work of the team assembled by the District Attorney led to the presentation of a 64-count racketeering indictment, along with several other indictments related to crimes of violence and possession of contraband in the jail.

On Wednesday, April 12, 2023, these indictments were presented to the Grand Jury, who returned True Bill indictments on 84 defendants. The racketeering case has been assigned to Chief Superior Court Judge Robert L. Mack.
