Clayton County District Attorney Tasha M. Mosley announces the conviction of Lorenzo Roberts. Following a bench trial, Judge Shana Rooks Malone rendered a guilty verdict on all counts.

During the trial, the State presented evidence that the defendant went to rob the victim Mr. Martir on the evening on July 23, 2024. When Mr. Martir refused to let them in his trailer, the robbers fired eight shots through the door, hitting Mr. Martir four times.

The State's case was led by Deputy Chief Assistant District Attorney Jamal Williams with Assistant District Attorney Lauren Young serving as the secondary prosecutor. Investigators Mike Hooks, Investigator Matthew Simonds, and Victim Advocate Nerissa Sims also played crucial roles in the prosecution of this case.

Judge Shana Rooks Malone presided over the trial and sentenced the Defendant to life without the possibility of parole plus 40 years to run consecutively.

District Attorney Mosley stated, *"We hope this conviction offers some measure of solace to the family of Mr. Martir. This conviction also reaffirms our unwavering commitment to pursuing justice and holding individuals accountable for their actions."*
