Clayton County District Attorney Tasha M. Mosley announces the conviction of Defendant Harvey Carter. A Clayton County jury rendered a guilty verdict on Possession of a Schedule II Controlled Substance.

During the trial, the State presented evidence showing that on December 31, 2020, Defendant Harvey Carter was in a vehicle being driven by his co-Defendant, and the vehicle was stopped due to a tint violation. A search was conducted on the vehicle based on drug's being in plain view. Defendant Carter was arrested, and after his arrest, Oxycodone was found on his person.

Assistant District Attorney Breanna McKnight led the State's case with Assistant District Attorney Anthony McKee serving as co-counsel. Investigator Geoffrey Holtzclaw played a vital role in the prosecution of this case, and securing the evidence needed for this conviction. The trial began on Tuesday, July 15, 2025, and concluded Wednesday, July 16, 2025.

Judge Jewel Scott presided over the trial and has set sentencing for August 6, 2025.

District Attorney Mosley stated, "We hope this conviction sends a clear message our office remains unwavering in its commitment to holding individuals accountable for their actions."
